North Asia and South East Asia

Good afternoon everyone,

Some good news as we close in on Christmas. We are pleased to advise that the PSS (Peak Season Surcharge) applicable to import seafreight from North Asia and South East Asia will be withdrawn from 15th December 2010.

Peak Season Surcharge (PSS) – Withdrawn effective 15/12/10

PSS will no longer apply from the below origin ports effective from ETD 15th December 2010. This applies to both LCL and FCL shipments.

North Asia - China, Hong Kong, Korea, Taiwan, Japan

South East Asia - Vietnam, Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, Singapore and the Sub-Continent

Holiday notice – Chinese New Year

With the Christmas rush all but over, we now focus our attention to the upcoming Chinese New Year in January / February 2011. This is the biggest event on the Chinese Calendar and a time where many business shut down altogether and workers go back to their families for celebrations.

The official Chinese New Year dates are as below:

- Hong Kong - from pm Wednesday, 02/02 to Sunday 06/02 inclusive = 4.5 days
- China - from Wednesday, 02/02 to Tuesday 08/02 inclusive = 7 days.

Last vessels prior to Chinese New Year will cut off in the week beginning 24th January 2010.
